In this proceeding concerning **Glenn Patrick Bogue**, 1985, of Toronto, the panel considered the Law Society of Ontario's motion for:

- an order under ss. 39(1) and 49.26 of the *Law Society Act* that the respondent be examined by Dr. Philip Klassen

The panel orders:

1. Pursuant to s. 39(1) of the *Law Society Act*, the respondent shall be examined by Dr. Philip Klassen on August 30 and 31, 2018, for the purposes of:
  - a. Determining whether the respondent is or has been incapacitated;
  - b. Determining the extent of any incapacity and prognosis for recovery; and
  - c. Determining what terms or conditions are required to protect the public interest.
2. The respondent shall answer Dr. Klassen's questions and shall cooperate with the examination process, including by participating in any relevant medical or psychological testing as required by Dr. Klassen, providing Dr. Klassen with any requested health records, and providing Dr. Klassen with any requested authorisation to obtain information from the respondent's health practitioners. If Dr. Klassen believes that the respondent's marriage counselling records are required for the assessment and the respondent objects, then the Law Society may bring a motion to this panel.
3. The respondent shall be examined at Dr. Klassen's office in Toronto or, at Dr. Klassen's discretion, at another medical centre or physician's office in Toronto.
4. Dr. Klassen may require the respondent to attend for up to three sessions of up to eight hours each, and if a third session is required after August 31, this session shall be scheduled as soon as possible.
5. In the event that Dr. Klassen would like to conduct more than three sessions with the respondent or to change the duration or location of the meetings, then the Law Society may bring a motion to this panel.
6. A copy of Dr. Klassen's report following the examination process shall be provided to the respondent and to the Law Society.
