

Robert Joseph Potomski (2008), of the City of Windsor, brought an application under s.49.43 of the *Law Society Act* for a determination of whether the Paralegal has met the terms and conditions of the Decisions and Orders of the Hearing Panel dated December 21, 2011 and May 13, 2013. That application was dismissed by Decision and Order of the Hearing Division dated August 21, 2014, but the hearing continued by way of written submissions.

By Order dated January 26, 2015, the Law Society Tribunal - Hearing Division ordered as follows:

1. The December 21, 2011 Decision and Order of the hearing panel, suspending the Paralegal's licence, remains in effect.
2. The stay of paragraph 4 of the May 13, 2013 Order is extended until and expires on the 30th day after the issuance of this order.
3. If the Paralegal's licence remains suspended pursuant to the December 21, 2011 Decision and Order on the 30th day after the issuance of this order, the Paralegal's licence shall be revoked effective the 31st day after the issuance of this order.
4. The Paralegal shall fully comply with the terms of the Law Society's *Guidelines for Former Paralegals Whose Licences Have Been Revoked or Who Have Been Permitted to Surrender Their Licences*.
5. The Paralegal shall pay costs to the Law Society in the amount of \$30,000 in three equal payments on or before the deadlines of October 31, 2015; October 31, 2016; and October 31, 2017. Starting the day following each deadline, interest shall accrue on any past-due part of these costs at the rate of 3% *per annum*.
